- 16:30: Prize giving ceremony in Puchberg, Schneeberghalle

**Track:** The track mainly follows the rack railway, so you are always in touch with the steam train. Starting area is located in the center of Puchberg (Schneeberghalle), after the start the train station is passed where the rack railway starts in the competition. Pass "Bahnstraße" into "Schneebergstraße", then cross the rack railway, after 300 m turn left to "Muthenhof" (Gasthaus Schmierl), from there 400 m to the beginning of the "Hengstweg" (km 2,0; 630 m). Run up the mountain on gravel, alongside the rack rails to the first service area next to "Hengsthütte" (km 5,2; 1012 m). From there at the upper "Hengstweg" to "Köglerhaus", cross the train into second service area (km 7,8; 1340 m), follow gravel road to train station "Baumgartner" (km 8,3; 1394 m). Then cross the train again after 500 m, on a path (forrest ground, rock) hike up to "Luxboden" (km 9,0; 1690m). From there 1,2 km and 110 m elevation difference to the Finish area at the train station Hochschneeberg (1800 m). You made it!!!

2 service areas with water and iso-drinks along the track

#### **Hall of Fame:**

The first to win Schneeberglauf in 1997 und 1998 was mountain running legend Peter Schatz. In the following years 1999 und 2000 Hans Kogler, vice world champion won the race, only once the rack railway won the race. 2001 Helmut Schmuck won in 55:17, in 2002 Manfred Tod won the first snow race. 2004 Alois Redl set a new track record (54:18), this year only beaten by the train (53:14, track record). In 2000 the legendary mountain runner Elisabeth Rust (†) won; her time of 1:04:22 setting a women's long-time record;

A new aera was started at the 10<sup>th</sup> Raiffeisen Schneeberglauf by Jonathan Wyatt, an outstanding athlete. The likeable, multiple winner of the world championship from New Zealand also succeeded at the Schneeberg, setting a new record with a time of 52:21; he also won in 2007 and 2008.

A new dimension was entered by Andrea Maier in the snow race in 2008 when she set the women's record at 58:21.
